Historical, geographical and etnichnyi aspects of jewish question at Russian empire in editorial policy of newspaper «Kievlyanin» in 1900–1914

The basic principles of editorial policy of newspaper «Kievlyanyn» on covering the historical foundations of coexistence between Jewish and Ukrainian peoples. The basic views of the newspaper regarding the role and place of Jews in areas of society Southwestern region of the Russian Empire in the early XX century. The principle of historicism in the study realized primarily in the study of specific historical circumstances in which it worked monarchical authority «Kievlyanyn» as well as the knowledge of the historical experience of the interaction of various ideological currents and systems.
