the enemy; in transitional wars (second-wave wars), it serves as a determining component in ensuring victory over the enemy; and in modern wars (third-wave wars), it serves as the dominant component, ensuring victory and functioning as the goal of war. The levels of information confrontation include: information resistance, information expansion, information struggle, and information aggression (information warfare).

The key factor in preventing the destructive impact of information-propaganda and information-psychological influences on the consciousness and psyche of military personnel is the level of individual information security.

Individual information security is developed through active and purposeful efforts, as well as the functioning of the social mechanism that shapes it. The social mechanism for forming individual information security is a system of organically interrelated elements, the main ones being: the goals of forming individual information security; a system of subject-object and subject-subject relations that develops and functions in the process of its formation; the methods, forms, and means of activities for developing individual information security; the subjects whose activities implement the laws governing its formation; and the conditions under which individual information security is shaped.

### **MILITARY-IDEOLOGICAL ACTIVITIES IN THE RUSSIAN ARMED FORCES DURING THE INITIAL STAGE OF THE FULL-SCALE INVASION OF UKRAINE (FEBRUARY 24, 2022 – SEPTEMBER 21, 2022)**

The fundamental trends that shaped the ideological support of the RA Forces during the first stage of Russia's full-scale armed aggression against Ukraine, their development, and certain transformations based on the results of the military-political and operational situation from February 24, 2022, to September 21, 2022 (the date of the decree on the "partial" mobilization of Russian Federation "citizens"), included the following components:

- Proclamation of a "sacred" mission – the "liberation of the Ukrainian people";
- Declarations of the priority of "humanistic" methods in implementing the processes of "denazification and demilitarization";
- Total imposition of labels such as "nationalists", "neo-Nazis", "Banderites", "fascists", and "drug addicts" in the information space targeting the military and political leadership of Ukraine;
- Use of historical memory mechanisms related to World War II;
- Application of a mythologized historical concept of the "unity of the Russian and Ukrainian peoples";
- Hypertrophied assessment of military "successes";
- Mobilization of the Russian Federation's population toward conscious self-isolation under unprecedented sanctions imposed by the anti-Putin coalition countries;
- Propaganda targeting the ideology of the OUN and positioning the UPA as purely collaborationist military formations;
- Activation of information and psychological operations.
